Date: Sun 29 January – Fri 3 February

Program: Sunday 29th : Arrival and welcome dinner in the evening
Monday 30th: 1st day of activities and dinner in the evening
Tuesday 1st: 2nd day of activities, evening free
Wed 2nd: 3rd day of activities, evening free
Thu 3rd: 4th day of activities and intercultural food festival
Friday 4th: City/Museum tour and closing lunch.

Location: The Hague University main campus, various locations throughout the city.

Requirements: None, except of course some teaching/coaching experience, an interest in intercultural awareness, and sufficient English language skills.

Preparation: In the week before we will organize a digital briefing session in preparation.

Practicalities: Unfortunately we cannot cover flight and travel expenses. We advise interested lecturers to apply for an Erasmus+ subsidy for staff mobility. The Hague University will offer lunches, a free public transport card as well as some social activities and dinners throughout the week. We can also assist with hotel booking in The Hague.
